Owner represents that he or she is the legal owner of the dog listed above and desires to participate in the Wiener Dog Races to be held at Sam Houston Race Park on March 19, 2022 (the "Event"). As a condition to Sam Houston Race Park, LLC ("SHRP") permitting the Owner to participate in the Event, Owner hereby agrees as follows:

Owner's private insurance is the only insurance coverage available to Owner who shall provide coverage for any injuries inflicted by or to Owner's dog(s). Owner further acknowledges and understands that he or she will be held responsible for any and all damage to persons or property that is caused by or related to Owner's participation in the Event. SHRP shall not be responsible for any costs incurred for or by misbehaved animals.

Owner consents to the use of his or her name and photo and any photos of his or her dog for publicity purposes.

Owner hereby releases and forever discharges, and waives any and all Claims (as defined below) against SHRP, its employees, officers, directors, shareholders, partners and affiliates (the "Released Parties") that relate to Owner's dog participation in the Event and agrees not to sue for those Claims. For purposes of this Agreement, "Claims" shall mean any past, present and future claims, losses, costs, expenses, liabilities, demands, or causes of legal action, and costs of defense or settlement (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees and court costs). Owner hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties against any and all Claims arising from or related to Owner's participation in the Event. This Agreement is binding on Owner and Owner's heirs and executors.

I have read the rules and waive any rights to and will not attempt to hold any party responsible if another dog bites my dog or me.

1) Here at SHRP we adore all dogs, however, only Wiener Dogs (DACHSHUNDS) will be permitted to race in this Event. SHRP reserves the right to determine which dogs can and cannot race. All dogs must be under 40 pounds.

2) All racers must complete this registration form and submit their dog's shot records.

3) The total number of heats and races are dependent on the total number of entries. This will be determined when you check in for the Event. First place for each heat will move on to a final championship heat.

4) All dogs must be accompanied by two people in order to race (one person at the starting gate and one at the finish line).

Racing tip Whoever retrieves the dog at the finish line must stand back 4-5 feet to allow your dog to cross. If you stand too close to the finish line your dog may slow down and not cross the finish line.

5) You may bring your dog's favorite toy to use during the race to encourage your racers. No lights, laser pointers, or items thrown down the track will be allowed. **NO FOOD/TREATS ALLOWED.**

6) All decisions regarding the call and placement/advancement of racers made by SHRP are final and not subject to review by Owners.

7) Once shot records, registration, and payment have been received your dog will be entered into the races.

8) All dogs must be on a leash at all times while not in the race area. Once finished with the races they must be put back on their leashes. Please note: If your dog bites another dog or human, you will be disqualified and asked to leave SHRP immediately.

9) It is the responsibility of the Owner to clean up after your dog while at SHRP.

10) Remember this is for FUN! While there are prizes to be won, unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
